SUBJECT: 2008 Third Quarter Traffic Activity Report

(July - September 2008)

The information provided herein represents the Madison Police Department's traffic enforcement activity for the third quarter of 2008.

In summary, all traffic citations issued for the third quarter totaled 6,110, which includes 4,376 citations for hazardous violations and 1,734 citations for non-hazardous violations. In addition, 512 traffic warnings were issued. Of these totals, the Traffic Enforcement Safety Team issued 919 citations, which includes 781 hazardous citations and 138 non-hazardous citations during this period. The two-year (2006-2007) average for total citations issued by the Department during the third quarter was 4,866. Also during this period, the average total number of citations issued by the Traffic Enforcement Safety Team was 606.

During the third quarter, Traffic Specialists investigated four (4) significant crashes, of which three (3) had fatalities and one (1) serious injury. Alcohol was a factor in two of the crashes referenced above. Of note however, is that statewide, 2008 year-to-date total fatal crashes are down 18% with total crash fatalities being down 21.3% from the same period in 2007. Within the City of Madison, 2008 year-to-date total fatal crashes are down 66.7% with total crash fatalities being down 53.4% from the same period in 2007. Exact causes affecting this decline are unknown.

The Speeders Hotline received 303 citizen calls during the third quarter, resulting in the mailing of a total of 124 warning letters. Crossing Guard observations resulted in 115 warning letters being forwarded and 7 citations issued.

During the third quarter, a number of overtime enforcement grants were scheduled. These grants were coordinated through the Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety. Impaired driver (OWI) and traffic safety enforcement initiatives occurred during July through part of September. Through these enforcement efforts, 255 citations were issued which included 14 arrests for OWI. In addition, 109 warnings were issued. Also during the third quarter, a Pedestrian and Bicycle Enforcement overtime grant was scheduled that focused on pedestrian safety and bicycle traffic violations. These grant initiatives yielded 125 citations and 1 warning.

#### **RIGHT OF WAY**

Any violations of Statute 346.18 that involve injury, great bodily harm, or death have an increased bail and should be charged accordingly. The bail for a failure to yield violation which caused injury is \$298.00/4 points, for a violation which caused great bodily harm the bail is \$676.00/4 points, for a violation which caused death the bail is \$1,306.00/4 points. Please indicate "injury," "great bodily harm" or "death" in the description of violation box on the Uniform Traffic Citation. For example, if you cited someone for 346.18(2) which involved an accident with an injury, you would use 346.18(2) for the statute number, the description of violation would read, "Failure to Yield Turning Left at Intersection (Injury)" and the fine would be \$298.00 with 4 points.
