The City of Madison is proposing to resurface North Sherman Avenue from Trailsway to Northport Drive. The project involves special assessments to owners of property adjacent to the project. You are being sent this letter to notify you of the public hearing before the Board of Public Works at the above referenced date, time & location. City Engineering will make a short presentation at the meeting, followed by the public hearing. Attached to this letter is a schedule of assessments that contains the estimated cost for each property adjacent to the project.

May 7, 2010

The proposed improvements include removal and replacement of damaged sections of curb and gutter, replacement of the asphalt pavement, installing storm sewer upgrades and replacement of damaged drive aprons and sidewalk as necessary.

Street Improvements

The proposed project incorporates design concepts for streetscape improvements as recommended in the recently adopted Northport-Warner Park- Sherman Neighborhood Plan. The proposed improvements include enhanced pedestrian crossings at intersections and the installation of median islands and turn lanes to improve pedestrian access and safety.

The proposed design includes two northbound through lanes with left-turn lanes at intersections and driveways and one southbound through lane, also with left-turn lanes at the intersections and driveways. The proposed design also includes on-street bike lanes in each direction. In order to accommodate the installation of median islands and bike lanes, the overall street section will be widened. The sidewalk on the Warner Park side of North Sherman Avenue will be shifted to the west in order to accommodate the widening of the street. The new sidewalk along Warner Park will be 6-feet wide. Sidewalk on the east side of North Sherman Avenue will remain in place and only damaged or offset sections will be replaced.

The cost of the street improvements will be shared by the City and the property owners adjoining the project. The City shares the cost on a 50-50 basis with the property owners for removing and replacing the curb and gutter, drive aprons and sidewalk adjacent to their property. The City assumes the entire cost for the replacing the pavement, storm sewer and curb and gutter and sidewalks at the street intersections and for the installation of median islands, and pedestrian crossing improvements. The attached Schedule of Assessments shows a breakdown of costs for each of the street improvement items and the total estimated cost to be assessed to each adjacent property owner. Glen Yoerger is the street designer for this project and you may contact him at 261-9177.

Storm Sewer

Storm sewer inlets and leads will be replaced as necessary as part of the project. This work is not assessed to property owners. Sally Swenson is the storm sewer designer for the project; you may contact her at 266-9721.

Impact on Trees and Landscaping

With the widening of the street, it will be necessary to remove some trees along the Warner Park side of North Sherman Avenue. Approximately 18 trees will need to be removed along the eastern edge of the Park. After completion of the project, new street trees will be replanted on each side of North Sherman Avenue, as well as additional trees along the eastern side of the Park. If, during the course of construction, it is determined that any additional trees must be removed, City Engineering will notify property owners adjacent to the trees to be removed, prior to removal.

Please note that construction will also have an impact on existing flower gardens and other plantings within the terrace. With the nature of this work, property owners should anticipate that most of the terrace will be disturbed, therefore, any plantings or special landscaping features that an owner wishes to save from damage should be removed from the terrace area prior to the start of construction.

Assessments - General

A special assessment is a special charge for work that the City is planning to complete. The attached schedule of assessments shows an estimate of the property owners' share of the project based upon the City's assessment policy. When the project is bid, and work is complete, a final assessment will be calculated based on work actually performed. The final assessment is payable in one lump sum or over a period of 8 years, with 3.5% interest charged on the unpaid balance.

That if the total assessment is paid in full before October 31st in the year that the billing is made, irrespective of project completion, then no interest shall be charged.
