Dear Ms. Senn,

Thank you for your Section 5310 grant application to continue funding for Metro Transit’s Paratransit Eligibility and Mobility Coordinator program for the 2019 calendar year. This 5310 grant cycle was the most competitive yet – with more projects than available funding. Your project was scored by an evaluation committee and is recommended for inclusion in the draft Program of Projects (attached) at the reduced funding level to allow for the funding of other high-scoring grant submittals. The recommended funding level is as follows:

Total Project Cost- Requested	\$99,500
Total Project Cost- MPO Adjusted	\$90,000
Section 5310 Funding	\$72,000

The draft Program of Projects, containing funding recommendations for the Section 5310 program, is attached and will be presented to the Madison Area Transportation Planning Board (MATPB) on October 3, 2018 at 6:30 pm at the Water Utility, 119 E. Olin Ave., Room A-B, in Madison. The Program of Projects (POP) is not considered final until it is approved by the MATPB as part of approval of the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), the TIP is approved by the state, and the POP is submitted to the Federal Transit Administration.

If you would like to appeal this process, please inform me in writing by noon, September 26, 2018. Your appeal will be included in meeting materials for the MATPB. MATPB meetings are open to the public.
