



## PUBLIC NOTICE

AT&T will be extending its fiber optic network within the City of Madison during the Month of August, 2013. This work is being done in order to enhance existing facilities in the Madison Area.

There will be a public hearing, before the City of Madison Board of Public Works, on Wednesday, August 7, 2013, at 5:30 p.m. in Room 108 of the City – County Building, 210 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd.

Cable installation contractors hired by AT&T will install fiber cables within the Roadway limits at the following location:

1. Construction begins on the south side of E. Washington, 225' northeast of Thierer Road heading southwest towards Thierer Road and continuing 460' along the northeast side of Thierer Road. Construction continues along the northwest side of East Towne Blvd ending 250' northwest of Thierer Road.

Handhole (access points) will be placed at the following locations:

Rear of 1773 Thierer Road in the East Towne Blvd grass terrace.

Cable will be directional bored and placed in the public ROW.

Restoration of any damage within the limits of the road right-of-way will be completed in accordance with the City of Madison's standard specifications. All damaged sidewalk slabs will be replaced with 5" lift concrete. All damage done to grass between sidewalk and curb will be restored with a four inch covering of black dirt and seed. All restoration required within the traveled portion of the roadway will also be completed in accordance with the City of Madison's standard specifications.
