2. [10137](#) Resolution that the position (#2785) of Transit Office Manager, in Compensation Group 43, Range 11, (occupied by A. Schroeder) in the permanent salary detail of the Metro Transit budget is repealed and recreated as a Transit Office Manager in Compensation Group 43, Range 12, thereof. Be it further resolved that the incumbent shall be reallocated to said position.

3. [10140](#) Resolution that the position (#3286) of Program Assistant 1, in Compensation Group 20, Range 11, (occupied by L. Starczewski) in the permanent salary detail of the Information Technology Department is repealed and recreated as a Program Assistant 2 in Compensation Group 20, Range 12, thereof. 9. [10204](#) Authorizing an amendment to the Metro Transit Advertising and Leased Space Policy to allow fully illustrated transit advertisements on Metro Coaches, not to exceed ten full wraps per year.
