6:30 PM: Alt Bratfest committee leaves the park

Site plan:

We are currently working with the Alder of the district, as well as Friends of Orton Park in determining the best layout for the event, including placement of music and grills. We will schedule a site visit with the East Parks Supervisor who will have the final say on the event set up.

Background Information:

We are planning an Alternative Bratfest at Orton Park on Sunday, May 29th, from 11-6. The time is approximate as we are still in the planning stages and it does not include setup and cleanup. We are planning to have an alt-country band play and sell locally produced foods such as brats, burgers and sausages. All the proceeds will go to local charities.

The event should be very low-key and family oriented. We will be actively encouraging people to arrive by bicycle, offering a discount on their meal if they arrive by bike.

Joey Dunscombe, the Chef at the Weary Traveler Freehouse on Williamson Street and I (Carrie Dainty) are organizing it with the help from some other Madison restaurants such as Alchemy Café and Underground Food Collective.
