However, a citizen member appointed to fill the unexpired term of a former member, <b>or appointed before April 30, 2014</b>, shall be eligible to serve two (2) full consecutive three-year terms. <b>OR</b></p> <p><b>Terms.</b> The terms of all commission members shall be for three (3) years or until their successors are qualified. However, the term of the aldermanic member shall expire with the expiration of her/his term as alderperson, and the members appointed to the first term following the effective date of this ordinance shall be appointed to staggered terms. Three (3) members shall serve an initial term of one (1) year, three (3) shall serve an initial term of two (2) years, and four (4) shall serve an initial term of the full three (3) years. No member shall serve more than two (2) consecutive three-year terms. However, the six (6) members appointed to the first term after the effective date of this ordinance who serve an initial term of less than three (3) years, and any member appointed to fill the unexpired term of a former member, shall be eligible to serve two (2) full consecutive three-year terms thereafter. Other than the term of the alderperson, all terms shall expire on April 30<sup>th</sup> and begin on May 1<sup>st</sup>.</p>
