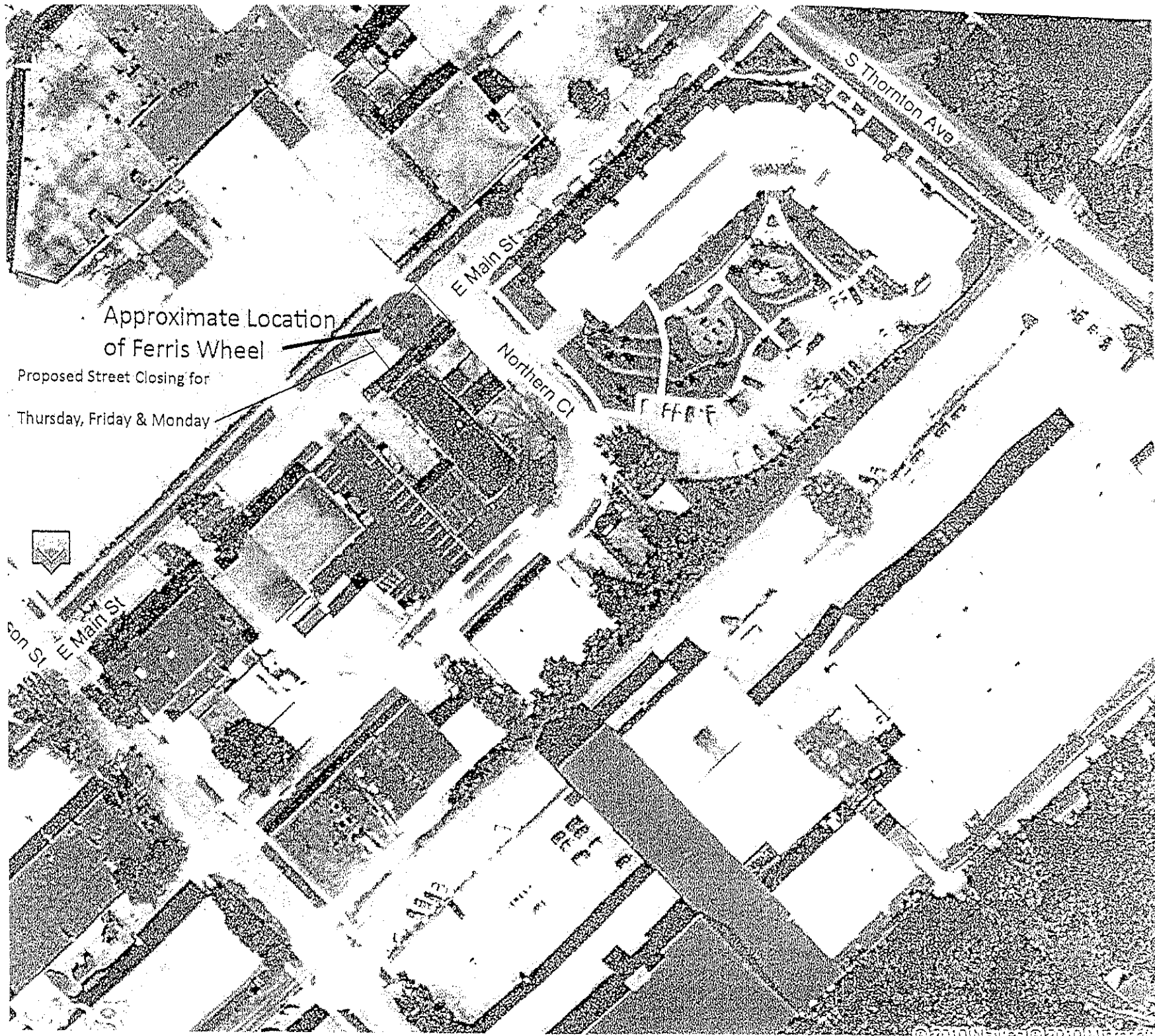

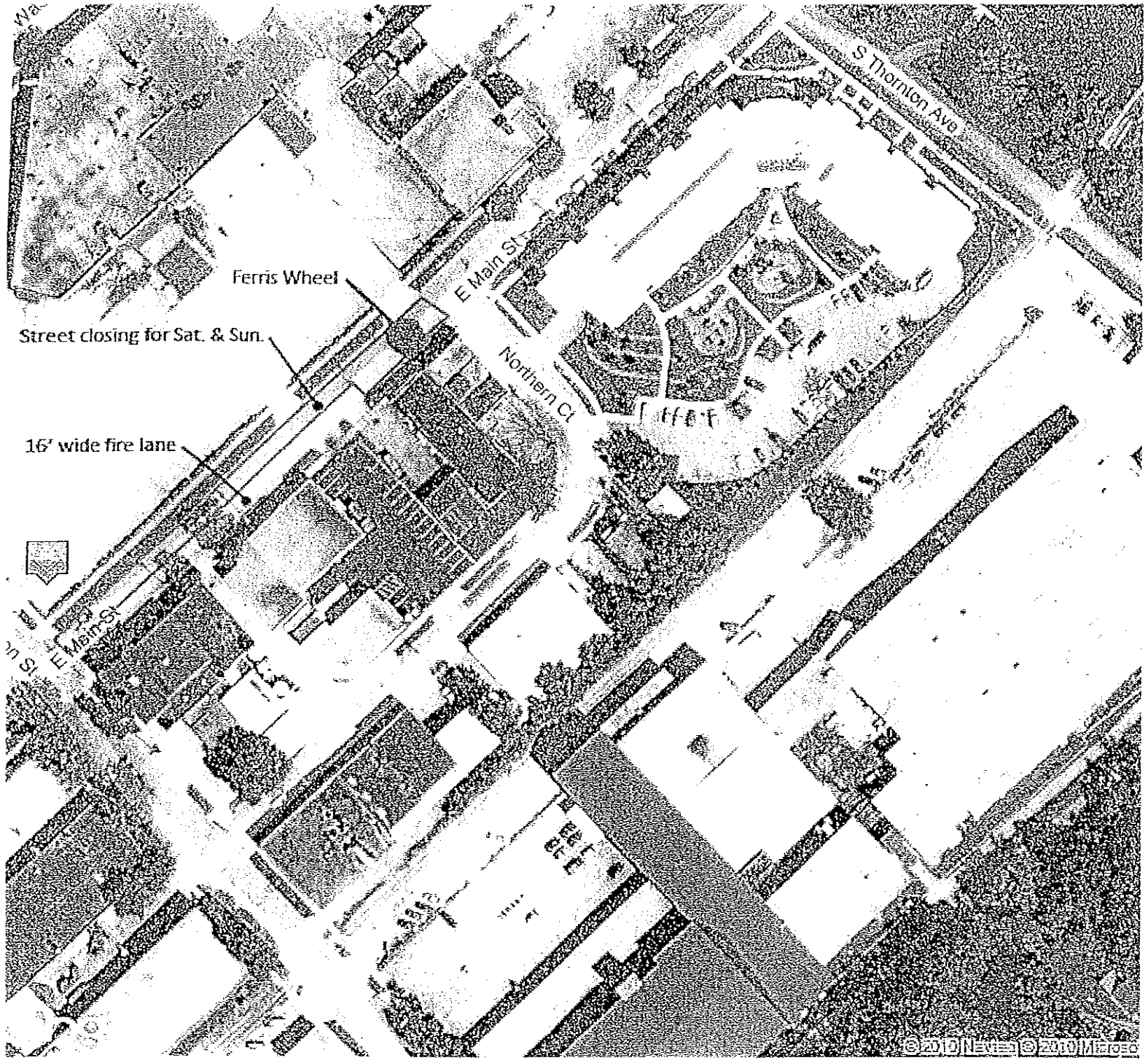


Approximate Location

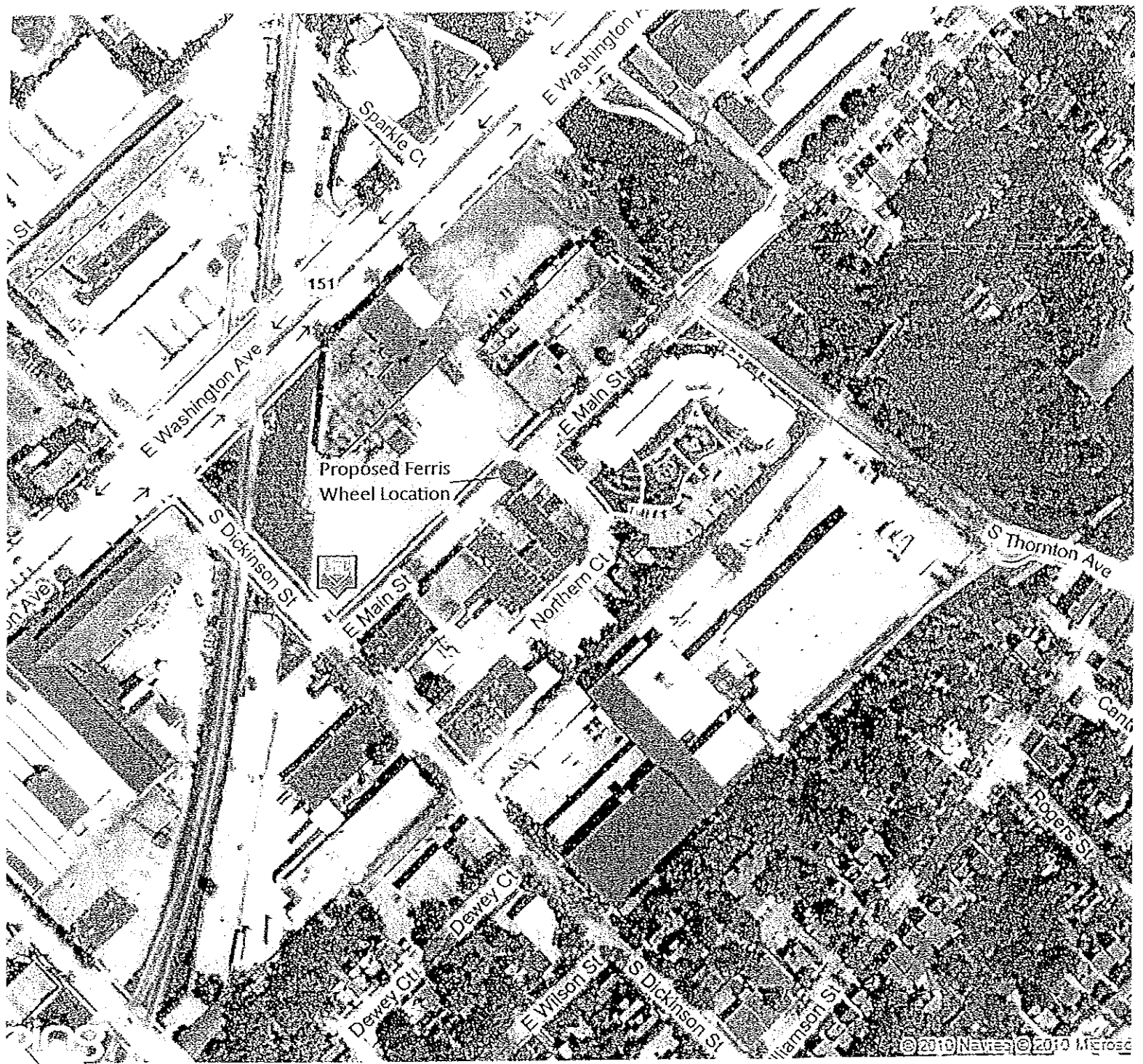
Street closing for Sat. & Sun.
