Introductions:

Opening Remarks:

There will be a brief presentation (no PowerPoint) that will quickly cover:

- OMSAC purpose and activities to date (including role of the City)
- Owners update (by owners or staff TBD)
- Next steps (including the Special Area Plan) and how input will be used
- Overview of room layout and “instructions” for the rest of the meeting

Open House:

The open house portion of the meeting will be formatted so that participants can “self navigate” to a number of stations to learn more about the area. Stations will have maps and data to help people understand the context of the area. Examples of stations may include: transportation (*moving around or connections*), land use and design (*placemaking*), parks and open space (*green spaces*), economic development (*jobs and the economy*), plan boundaries, etc.

There will also be several stations where participants can talk directly to staff, Committee members, and consultants about what they see as opportunities and to share their concerns. Each of these stations will be the same to ensure there is ample access to share their thoughts.

Participants can spend as much or as little time as they want at each station.
