Dear Members of the Alcohol License Review Committee (ALRC) and Alder Evers,

I am writing to respectfully oppose the application by Becco, Inc. for a Class A Liquor/Beer/Cider license at 421 S. Park Street. As a neighbor who lives directly behind the proposed location and borders Brittingham Park, I am deeply invested in the safety and well-being of this specific community area.

I have reviewed the application and acknowledge the business owners' stated goal of providing a clean, responsible, and community focused establishment. However, regardless of the applicant's positive intentions and established reputation in Stoughton, this specific location is simply not right for our community.

My opposition is due to the close proximity of this off premises alcohol outlet to Brittingham Park. Past experience has shown that increased accessibility to packaged alcohol exacerbates public safety challenges in this area, leading to disturbances, increased litter, and problematic behavior.

For many years, neighbors and city staff have invested significant time to reverse the park's reputation and make it a safe, family-friendly space. Introducing a new, high-volume off-premises liquor store—as proposed at 421 S. Park Street—risks undermining these hard-won efforts and reversing the progress that has been made in the neighborhood.

I urge the ALRC to deny the Class A license for this location to protect the character, safety, and quality of life of the residential neighborhood and Brittingham Park.
