



DANE COUNTY EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION DEMOGRAPHIC REPORT 2011

Enrollment data is from March 2011. The school age enrollment does not include numbers from the Madison Public School Community Recreation Program's after school program (though they are included on the chart analyzing school age program enrollment) nor are 4 year old kindergarten (4K) programs included that are inside public school buildings. Wisconsin Shares enrollment only includes those children from Dane County enrolled in programs within Dane County.

While the recession continues to effect child care and early childhood education programs especially family child care, for the first time in five years there has not been a significant drop in total enrollment. Capacity and the amount of options parents have do continue to decline. Family child care continues to take most of the loss. Part of the increase in full day and school age program enrollment/capacity is actually a shift in what categories centers were listed under. Some YMCA school age site now have full day preschools attached causing them to change categories to full day programs. While not obvious from the above chart parents shifting from full time to part time care is occurring in many programs including full day group centers and family child care. While some of this was due to the growth of 4 year old programs in the public schools, reduced hours at work seem to be the major reason. Many part day preschools also reported parents just not enrolling children due to lost income and thus not being able to afford preschool enrichment programs for their children.

While child care services will be in less demand during a recession, they will be a critical component in any future economic recovery. As the recession continues it can be expected that more programs, especially family child care may close. Strategies to stabilize child care during the recession and to rebuild it as the economy rebounds will continue to be critical activities in 2011. It is hoped that flat enrollment this year is the first step to a rebounding economy.

Four year old kindergarten has both positive and negative effects on the child care market. It seems to be a contributing factor to the decrease in full time enrollment and the shift from family child care to group centers. On the other hand for those programs that had on site community based 4K programs, it often insures their programs are fully enrolled during the recession. Most importantly where there was 4K, children had access to preschool programs when otherwise they would not have been enrolled in child care or preschool due to the recession. The total enrollment figures for March 2011 would be hundreds of children lower if not for community based 4K classrooms. Next year's report will show the impact of the Madison School's system new 4K program on the child care market.
