The Board of Health for Madison and Dane County 2008 WIC Contract Amendment

Resolution #2008-01

The Dane County Division of Public Health and the Madison Department of Public Health both had contracts with the State of Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services Division of Public Health for the WIC program for January 1, 2006 to December 31, 2010. The two contracts have been consolidated into one. The Department has received the 2008 amendment for the WIC Program. The contracted caseload for this period is 6,315 clients. The Department will receive \$913,330 for these services, although there is an expectation that additional funds will be added later for special projects such as peer breastfeeding counseling and the Farmer's Market.

The Board of Health is authorized to accept continuation grants that had been previously approved by the County and City (IGA, VIII, F, 1).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Health for Madison and Dane County, on behalf of Public Health—Madison and Dane County authorizes the acceptance of the 2008 Amendment to the WIC contract offered by the Division of Public Health, Wisconsin State Department of Health and Family Services for \$913,330 for the period January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008, and the Director is authorized to sign the contract agreements.
