




- ☐ The budget is divided between the Operating Budget and the Capital Budget.
- □In 2024, the Operating Budget is \$789.3 million and the Capital Budget is \$179.2 million.
- □The tax rate in 2024 is \$2.72 for every \$1,000 of value, so a home valued at \$400,000 paid \$1088.00 in county property taxes. (\$400,000/1,000) x \$2.72.



The Budget Process







May - The County Executive distributes budget guidelines to departments.

May-July -Departments prepare their budget requests for the next calendar year.

<u>July-August</u> -The Department of Administration and the County Executive review budget requests. Copies of requests are available in the County Board Office, and the Department of Human Services (DHS) posts its request online.





September - Departments present their budget requests at a hearing before the County Board. This year the hearings will be on September 11 and 12.

<u>August-September</u> - The County Executive prepares the Annual Budget.

<u>September 18</u> -The County Executive releases her Proposed Budget and appropriations and tax levy setting resolutions are introduced and referred to the Personnel and Finance Committee.

<u>October</u> - The Operating and Capital Budget Resolutions are introduced. The public hearing on the County Executive's Proposed Budget is held before the Board. The public hearing will be on October 9 and will be held remotely.





October

- County Board Committees review and make recommendations for amendments to the Personnel and Finance Committee. This process is delineated in Chapter 7.24 of the Code of Ordinances.
- The Personnel and Finance Committee considers standing committee recommendations regarding amendments and makes recommendation on the Operating and Capital budget resolutions to the full County Board.
 - October 15, Personnel and Finance and Board of Estimates meeting to consider PHMDC budget



• A public hearing to provide an opportunity for testimony on the budget recommendations from the Personnel and Finance Committee, this year's hearing will be held on October 28.



<u>Late October – Early November</u> - The County Board adopts the Operating and Capital Budget Resolutions and sets the tax levy.

<u>November</u> - The County Executive has until the next County Board meeting, but a minimum of six days, excluding Sundays, to return any budget vetoes to the Board.

If there are vetoes, the County Board will meet to consider veto override motions and, if necessary, re-set the tax levy.

Increase expenditures by \$237,600 divided between the City of Madison and Dane County as \$104,332 for the City of Madison and \$133,268 for Dane County to create 2.0 N18 Patient Navigator positions in the Public Health Department.

Add the following language to 2022 RES-208: "The County operating budget includes the addition of 2.0 FTE Patient Navigator positions. The creation of the two positions is contingent upon the City of Madison including funding for the two positions in its adopted budget. If the City of Madison does not include funding for its share of the two positions, then only one Patient Navigator position will be created and the full cost will be borne by Dane County."
