77431 Recreate vacant Transit Operator Full Time positions #4343, 4351, 5028, 5031, and 5032 into three (3) Transit Class A Mechanic positions and one (1) Transit Class B Mechanic position in the permanent salary detail of Metro

Transit's operating budget.

3. SUBSTITUTE- Amending Planning's 2023 Capital Budget to appropriate

\$10,000 in private donations and approving a non-competitive sole-source
contract with Austen Brantley to create and install a sculpture for the
Darbo-Worthington-Starkweather Neighborhood and authorizing the

acceptance of outside funding for the project.

4. 77485 A Resolution authorizing a sole source contract for prescribed grazing services from Haakhagen Goat Grazing LLC for sustainable vegetation management on a (3) year term for the City of Madison Parks.

Amending the 2023 Adopted Mayor's Office Sustainability Improvements Project Capital Budget to accept a \$429,746 grant award from U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA); authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute the associated grant agreement with U.S. EPA; and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk enter into a non-competitive contracts with Foundation for Black Women's Wellness, Inc., Latino Health Council, The Hmong Institute, Inc., and the University of Wisconsin-Madison to implement the Building Sensor and Community Partnership Networks for Air Quality project.
