The owner of the business has been unwilling to work with us and has declared that she thinks our comfort in our own homes is unimportant and that we are "Overreacting".

My home has been repeatedly invaded by the loud music and the bass of the music that the Bar has played. There is no escape when they play it so loud that it can be heard and felt over my own TV, Sound Machines, Fans and air conditioner.

This is my home. I can not simply move because someone has decided that their business needs to be able to play music so loud that it can be felt and heard all the way across the street and through the cement walls of my home.
