

Hello,

When a biker in an on-street bike lane approaches a roundabout like the one proposed for High Point & Raymond Rd, they can escape to the sidepath (blue) or they can stay in road (purple):



I've noticed that some drivers don't realize bicyclists have the purple option and are surprised when a bicyclist takes it. I think a simple solution bit of education is a well-placed sharrows after the split:



Please ask Traffic Engineering to make this sharrows placement standard on all roundabouts in Madison.
