

Public Notice

Charter will be extending its fiber optic network in the City of Madison during May through July of 2009. This work will be done to upgrade the existing facilities on the west side of Madison.

There will be a public hearing before the City of Madison Board of Public Works, on Wednesday, April 22 2009 at 5:30 p.m. in room 108 of the city county Building, 210 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Madison, WI.

Contractors hired by Charter Communications will bury the new fiber optic/coax line within the road right of way limits at the following locations:

- 1. Beginning at the northwest corner of the intersection of South High Point Rd. heading south in the road right of way along of South High point Rd. to the intersection of South High Point and Raymond Rd. The fiber will be in the west terrace area.
- 2. Beginning at the south west corner of the intersection at Raymond Rd. and South High Point Rd Charter will place a 32" by 50" metal cabinet. From that cabinet Charter will bore 65' across the road to the north side of Raymond Rd. in the road right of way to the north east corner of the intersection of Marty Rd and Raymond Rd. then head north 90' to the first Alliant Energy pole on Marty Rd.
- 3. Beginning at the south west corner of the intersection of Raymond Rd and South High Point a coax cable will be placed heading west on the south side of Raymond Rd. right of way to the intersection of Raymond Rd and Oakview Dr.

The fiber optic cable and/or will be directional bored and trenched in the public road right of way.

Restoration of any damage within the limits of the project in the right of way will restored in accordance with the City of Madison standard specifications. All damage done to terrace area will be restored with black dirt and seed.
