Re: Certificate of Appropriateness for 1254 Rutledge Street

At its meeting on September 16, 2019, the Landmarks Commission reviewed, in accordance with the provisions of the Historic Preservation Ordinance, your plans to alter the exterior of the structure located at 1254 Rutledge Street in the Third Lake Ridge historic district. The Commission approved a Certificate of Appropriateness for the exterior alterations and repairs as proposed with the following conditions:

- The water table be reconstructed to include the quarter-round wood trim underneath the drip edge
- Specifications for the cellar door be approved by staff
- Specifications for the new attic window be approved by staff

This letter will serve as the "Certificate of Appropriateness" for the project described above. When you apply for a building permit, take this letter with you to the Building Inspection Counter, Department of Planning and Development, 215 Martin Luther King Jr Blvd, Suite 017.

Please note that any scope of work or design changes from the alterations approved herein must receive approval by the Landmarks Commission, or staff designee, prior to commencing with the work. This Certificate is valid for 24 months from the date of issuance.

Please also note that failure to comply with the conditions of your approval is subject to a forfeiture of up to \$500 for each day during which a violation of the Landmarks Commission ordinance continues (see Madison General Ordinances Chapter 41, Historic Preservation Ordinance).
