Cycropia Aerial Dance proudly presents its magical blending of modern dance and circus arts in three performances of spectacular works, as it brings "Saturniidae" (pronounced sa-turn-EYE-dee) to the Boys and Girls Club of Dane County. Audiences will have three chances to see this performance, Friday, March 29, at 7:30 p.m. and Saturday, March 30, at 2:00 and 7:30 p.m.

Using Cycropia's signature low-flying trapezes, bungees, silks, steel pole, and other aerial apparatus, performers will play with gravity and verticality as they dance suspended from the ceiling. Even the transitions between pieces will delight and entertain. The name of the show, "Saturniidae," refers to a family of moths that includes some of the largest and most magnificent insects known, including Cycropia's namesake, the cecropia moth.

Cycropia has been performing in Madison for over 20 years, creating a favorite Madison community dance tradition. Boys & Girls Club CEO Michael Johnson says he is thrilled to have Cycropia perform at the Club.

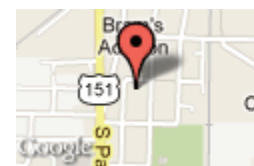
