Intermodal Transit Center

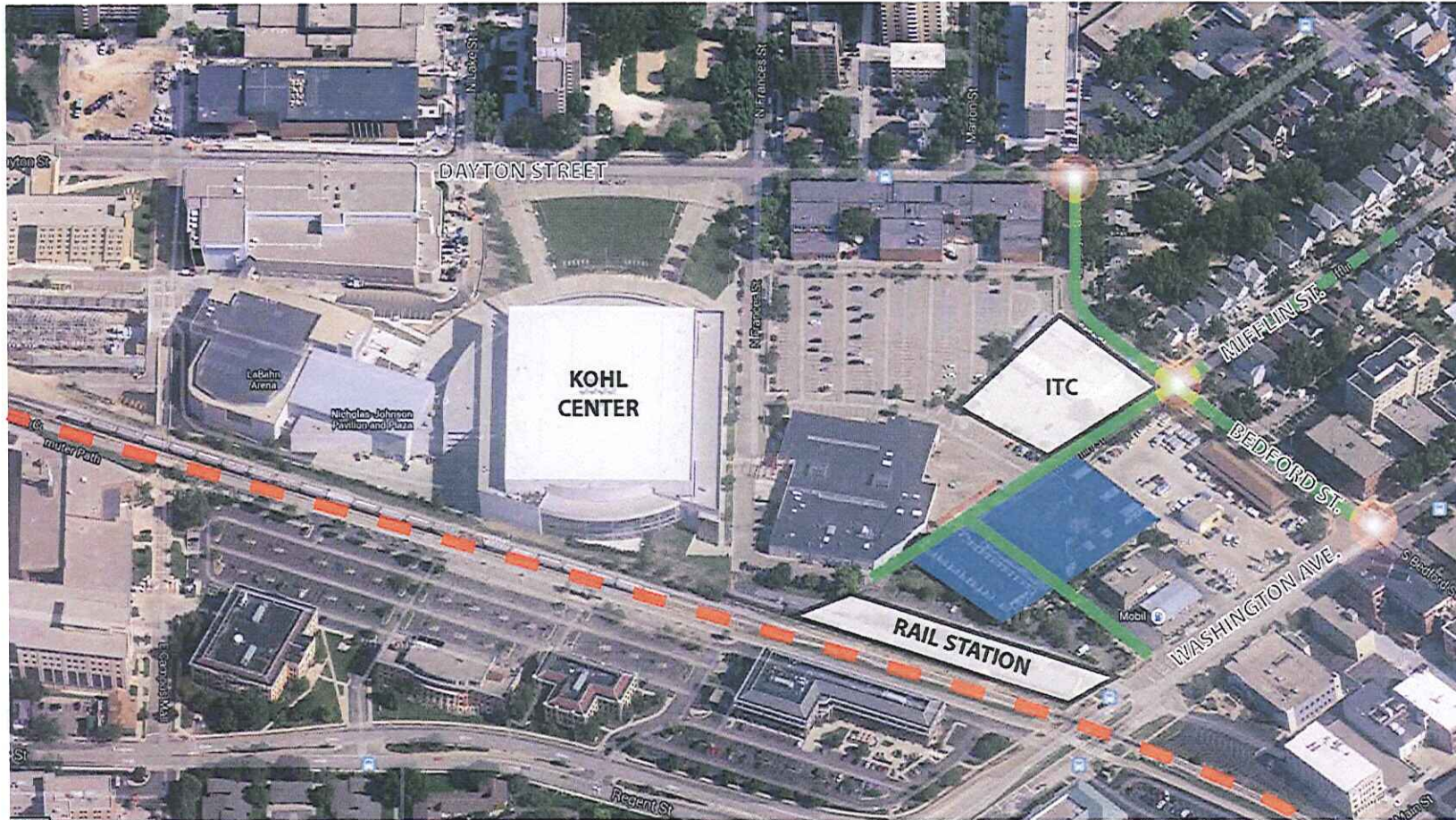
Amenities
