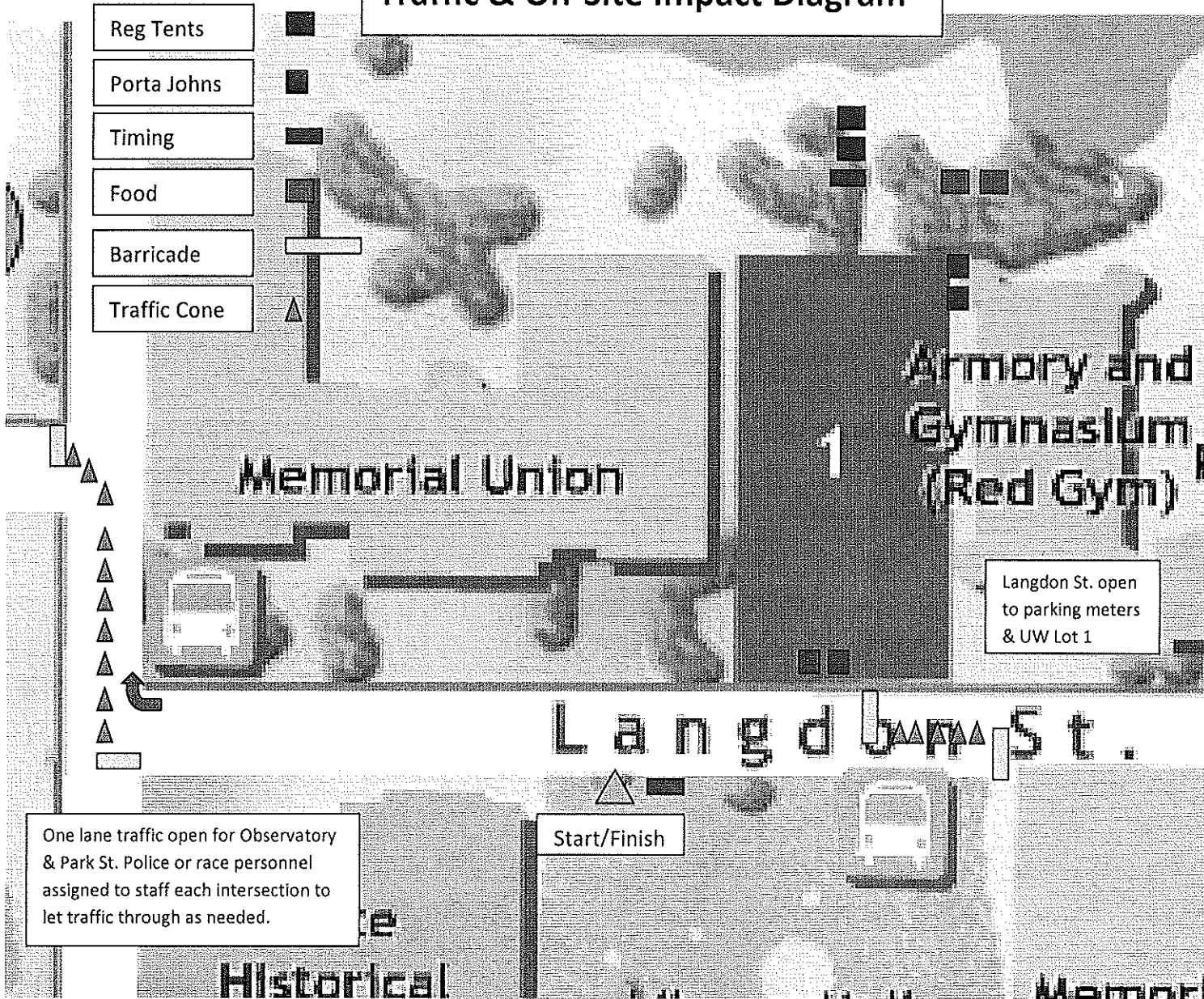

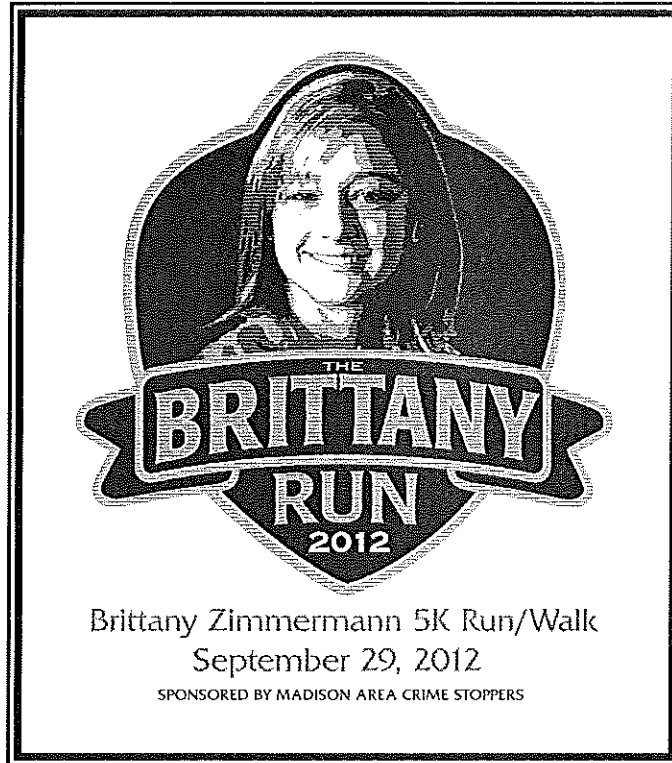

Traffic Plan

The 800 Block of Langdon will be partially shut down from 7am-10:30am

Registration and set up will take place north of the drive way to Memorial Union. (Depending on construction in the Memorial Union or Mall area.)

Traffic Post at N. Park St at Langdon (8:00a-10:00a)

Traffic will be reduced to one lane and monitored by Traffic Post Volunteers to flow both directions from North Park Street to Observatory Drive. No Right Turn allowed from North Park Street to Langdon Street.

Traffic Post at Lake Street and Langdon (8:00a-10:00a)

Traffic will be allowed to use parking meters on both side of the street.

Traffic will be allowed to come and go from Lot 6 at Memorial Union from Langdon St.

Traffic not allow to North Park Street.

Once the last runner goes by, you will switch modes to incoming runners.

Orange cones and barricades will be used.
