"Sliding Scale" Method of Compliance

Committee discussed the point system to be assigned to sweatfree compliance in the evaluation of bids using the perspective of the local preference purchasing policy that allocates 5% of the total available points in a request for proposal or gives 1% price preference in bids to approved registered local vendors.

Committee focused on two tasks:

(1) Set the gate for compliance. Determine how to figure that level by analyzing the process and details of a previous bid and testing the principles of the gate concept to the bid. Establish a method and schedule for improving compliance by raising the gate incrementally over the period of the contract and over time. Consider setting the gate at a lower level with the goal of monitoring performance by raising the gate annually at each renewal period, by calendar year, or as necessary. Committee will need to review the schedule of upcoming bids in order to determine how to increment the gate and target renewal periods. Committee to analyze how the process would affect different bids and how to implement a method that would be consistent for all bids. (2) Determine the overall value/percentage to be assigned to sweatfree compliance.

Committee to look at ways in which agencies can specify clothing that already meets the sweatfree requirement (e.g., union made, US made sweatfree apparel, etc.) when going out for bids.

#### 4. 22537 Vendor Education

Implement strategy to engage vendors to improve compliance. Conduct vendor education in a way that will improve/increase vendors' range of effort naturally. Consider a projected 10% riser (gate) every year. Continue to work on the City's process of increasing compliance until such time that an independent system that provides access to required information (such as factory locations, code of conduct compliance, etc.) through a nationwide database that is being developed by the Sweatfree Purchasing Consortium becomes available.
