Common Council Chief of Staff (CoS) Updates 10/15/19

- The survey on the Chief of Staff position will be send out in the next week. I would like to thank all alders and the HR Department for the support and feedback.
- Starting this week until November 23rd, Ms. Denita Baptista, a professional fellow of the 2019 Young South East Asian Leadership Institute will be visiting and shadowing me to learn how the legislative process works and how the City delivers services to residents. Denita is a Communication Associate with the United Nations World Food Program. Denita is visiting from Timor-Leste and for her project, she wants to develop an understanding of local leadership and constituent engagement and how private organizations engage with government. She also wants to learn how we advance civic engagement as a city.
- I participated in a work shop at the urban league along with City staff in Planning and Economic Development as well as Deputy Mayors. The objective was to hear concerns about gentrification on the Southside of Madison as well as learning about how Asset Based Community Development has been applied in Milwaukee and other cities to empower residents and boost economic development in blighted neighborhoods. Case studies included the Dudley Street Neighborhood Initiative in Boston, community wealth building by the Sherman Phoenix model (https://www.fixdevelopment.com/projects/sherman-phoenix/), the Genesis II Housing Cooperative in Chicago and the Lindsay Heights Community Wealth Building Campaign.
- Along with some alders, I attended the Dane County Housing Summit and attended breakout sessions on building sustainable and racially equitable communities.
