There were four primary topics:

- 1. Useable space, which refers to the presence within the sidewalk cafe perimeter of public amenities such as tree grates.
- 2. Allowing fee credits for sidewalk cafes that are regularly diminished by special events.
- 3. Allowing fee credits for some construction circumstances.
- 4. Consider possible exemptions, such as a particular block of a street not being subject to prevailing sidewalk cafe fees.

Verveer moved and Wood seconded to approve version two. The motion carried. Verveer and Wood agreed to sponsor.
