To: Property Owners, Residents and Business Owners along East Johnson Street

Re: Proposed Street Reconstruction Project & Public Hearing

The City of Madison is planning a 2019 construction project on E Johnson Street between N Baldwin St and N First St. The proposed project will include street improvements and replacement of the sanitary sewer, water main and partial replacement of storm sewer. Enclosed with this letter is a fact sheet with some details on the proposed project, which includes a map of the proposed project limits. Also enclosed is a notification for the Public Hearing before the Board of Public Works. The date, time and location of the public hearing is on the notification.

This project will involve special assessments to the owners of property adjacent to the project. The property owners will be assessed for various items included with this proposed project, and the costs of some of those items are assessed entirely to the owner. A table detailing the City's standard assessment policy for the items of work is included on the fact sheet.

Also enclosed is a Schedule of Assessments, which shows the estimated costs for each property adjacent to the project. After the work is complete, a final assessment will be calculated based on bid prices and work actually performed. The final assessment, which will be billed after the completion of the project, is payable in one lump sum or over a period of 8 years, with 3% interest charged on the unpaid balance.

That on <u>WEDNESDAY</u>, <u>MAY 16, 2018 AT 5:30 P.M.</u>, the Board of Public Works will hold a public hearing in <u>ROOM 108 (PARKS CONFERENCE ROOM) OF THE CITY COUNTY BUILDING</u> and will consider any objections that may be filed in writing or in person and hear all persons desiring to be heard, and;

That special assessments may be paid over an eight (8) year period, with the owner paying 1/8 of the principal each year plus three (3%) percent interest on the unpaid balance, as determined by the Board of Public Works.

That if the total assessment is paid in full before October 31st in the year that the billing is made, irrespective of project completion, then no interest shall be charged.

## Fact and Details Sheet Proposed E Johnson Street Reconstruction

#### Project Details – Proposed Work

Sanitary Sewer: The City will replace the existing sewer main with 12" PVC pipe (existing 10" cast iron installed in 1958), and in most cases replace laterals from the main to the property line. In limited cases where the existing lateral is cast iron, appears to be in good condition upon inspection, and runs under a tree, the lateral will only be replaced to the back of curb. In those cases, the owner will not be assessed for the additional footage of replacement that is not completed. If you would like a full lateral replacement to the property line in cases such as this, please contact the Sanitary Sewer Contact listed at right (laterals assessable).

Water Main: The City will replace the existing water main with 12" ductile iron pipe (existing 12" sand cast iron main was installed in 1928 and existing 4" sand cast iron main was installed in 1923), and reconnect services to the new main.

Storm Sewer: The existing storm sewer trunk-line will remain within the project limits. Proposed inlets locations will be reconfigured and connected to the existing trunk line. Any private storm connections (typically from sump pumps or downspouts) will be reconnected to the storm sewer system. If you are aware of any existing private storm sewer or private connections that discharge to the curb or to a structure from your property, please contact the Storm Sewer contact listed at right (private connections assessable).

Street: The City will remove the concrete pavement and replace with asphalt pavement and new gravel base. The curb and gutter will be replaced on both sides of the street for the entire length of the project (curb and sidewalk). As part of the reconstruction bus stop and pedestrian and bicycle crossing improvements will be made. Existing sidewalk will be spot replaced as needed and new 10-foot wide multi-use path, 1-foot-wide buffer and 5-foot-wide sidewalk will be constructed along the south side of East Johnson Street from the Yahara River through First Street. The proposed project also includes widening of First Street (STH 113) between East Johnson Street and East Mifflin Street to provide two southbound lanes to East Washington Avenue and to provide dual left- and right-turn lanes at the East Johnson Street intersection.

Street Lights: There will be new street lighting along both sides of E Johnson Street and along the west side of the N First Street between the sidewalk and concrete curb for the entire length of the project (lighting assessable).

Trees: Terrace trees may be pruned prior to construction to provide required clearance for construction equipment. Efforts have been made in the street design to save as many of the existing trees as possible. If, during the course of construction, it is determined that any additional trees must be removed, adjacent property owners will be notified, prior to removal of the tree. The trees within the project limits that remain may have the roots trimmed during construction. Terrace areas will be evaluated by Forestry for new trees or replacements following the project.

**Driveway Aprons:** Driveway aprons will be replaced to match the existing driveway width at the back of the sidewalk (*drive aprons assessable*). The driveway aprons will have a two-foot flare on each side as it matches the back of curb. Some residential properties have an apron wider than the existing driveway, if you wish to have a wider apron installed, please contact the project manager.

#### **Construction Schedule & Impacts**


Tentative Schedule: March 2019 - November 2019

**Traffic Impacts:** During construction, both East Johnson Street and First Street (STH 113) will be constructed in multiple stages to maintain at least one lane of traffic in each direction. Short term closures of E Johnson Street and Fordem Avenue will be required during construction and directional detours will be utilized.

Pedestrians will be accommodated throughout construction. One side of the street will remain open to pedestrians at all times. Intersections will be staged so that at least one crosswalk is provided across each street at the intersections of Fordem Avenue and First Street (STH 113).

Water Shut-offs: An average of two water shut-offs are expected for each property within the project limits. A minimum of 48 hours of notice will be provided prior to the shut-offs. Each shut-off may last up to 8 hours, but typically last about 4 hours. At the start of construction, the existing main will remain in service until the new main is installed and connected to; emergency shut-offs may occur if the old, brittle main is damaged during construction.

**Refuse Collection:** It will be the contractor's responsibility to allow for refuse collection to continue during construction. Please mark your address on your cart to make sure it is returned if moved.
