MGO 12.129(2)

No operator of any motor bus weighing over eight thousand (8000) pounds shall permit such motor bus to remain stationary with the main power train motor running for more than fifteen (15) minutes when such motor bus is on a highway abutting a residential building and when the outside air temperature is between 40°F and 80°F.

MGO 12.915(7)(f)

(f) No operator of any large motor truck shall permit such vehicle to remain stationary with the main power train motor running for more than fifteen (15) minutes when the outside air temperature is between 40°F and 80°F. This subsection shall not apply to maintenance, construction or public utility vehicles. (Renum. by Ord. 12,777, 3-13-01)
