**Program: Children's Immunizations** 

Eligibility: free for all

Availability: year-round

Children can receive the vaccines they need at any time with no insurance required.

This program is open to everyone, including children who:

- Don't have health insurance
- Are on Medical Assistance or BadgerCare
- Are Native American or Alaska Native

#### **Program: Adult Immunizations**

Eligibility: free for adults 19+ without insurance

Availability: year-round

Any adult who is nineteen or older and does not have insurance may receive certain vaccines at no cost.
