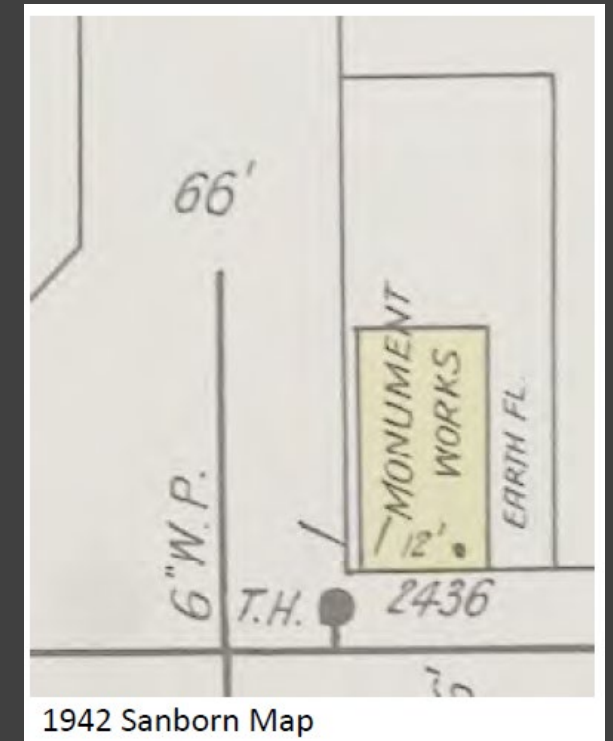




# 2436 Regent Street
