**SUMMARY:**

Buildings proposed for demolition:

210 Langdon Street

330 East Wilson Street

6001 Odana Road

The Landmarks discussed the historic character of the Langdon Neighborhood and the Langdon Street National Register Historic District.

**ACTION:**

A motion was made by McLean, seconded by Rummel, to convey to the Plan Commission that the Landmarks Commission is opposed to the demolition of the rear portion of the structure for a number of reasons including the loss of a historic/contributing structure in a National Register Historic District in relation to the recommendations in the Downtown Plan, the structure’s proximity to a local landmark, and the c. 1920s remodeling by master architect, Frank Riley. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

The other buildings were found to have no known historic value.
