The following is a proposed change order to add the UW-Madison duct bank to the University Ave. Campus Drive Intersection project. This proposal is based on plan sheets E101, E102, and E103 dated 5-6-10. No specifications were included. This proposal includes the following items:

- Construction fencing for our work
- Install and remove temporary pedestrian bridge for South side of University
- Remove and replace the existing private light pole
- Sawcut and remove the concrete sidewalk, colored and stamped pavement, and drive apron
- Sawcut and remove bituminous pavement - at parking lot
- Remove standing curb
- Remove 12" RCP, install temporary plastic storm, and reinstall 12" RCP after backfilling duct bank
- Dewatering for our work
- Excavation and backfill for duct bank - import select backfill under pavement and sidewalk
- Shoring for our work

- Temporary support for utilities during trenching
- 6" of clearstone bedding
- Cut into the existing vaults for duct bank tie in
- Dowel rebar into existing vaults to tie into new ducts
- Waterproof sawn openings, waterproof exterior of duct bank/vault joints
- Duct banks including; conduit, spacers, paver blocks, rebar, concrete encasement
- Duct bank testing pull mandrel, clean interior with a brush
- Furnish and install warning tape 12" below the surface
- Necessary overtime, manpower/equipment costs to complete prior to August 20, 2010
- Layout for our work
