



ACCOMPLISHMENTS TO DATE

- May 2013 MOST Coordinator hired part-time by the City of Madison to work in Brentwood and coordinate MOST activities
- July 2013 MOST Coalition meeting July 19, 2013. Invitation to Coalition
- July 2013 MOST preliminary Concept Paper presented to Coalition at July 19, 2013 meeting
- July 2013 Action Team formalized and began meeting regularly; twice a month
- Sept. 2013 Madison school district began negotiating with the City on contributing funding to increase coordinator position to full-time
- Oct. 2013 Action Team infrastructure/policies/procedures established
- Nov. 2013 Structure established for MOST initiative – Coalition-Workgroups-Action Team-City Education Committee-Administration Committee
- Nov. 2013 City Education Committee adopts MOST Initiative as one of its key initiatives
- Nov. 2013 MOST Coordinator positions moves full-time, jointly funded by the City of Madison and Madison Metropolitan School District
- Nov. 2013 MOST brochure created
- Dec. 2013 Learning Event hosted Dec. 6, 2013 bringing approximately 135 out-of-school time stakeholders together to discuss the national landscape of OST system development and share what is happening in Madison
- Dec. 2013 Data & Management Information (MI) System workgroup and the Family and Youth Engagement workgroup charges drafted
