- Building Block 4: Clear Work Plan to Implement




Building Block 1: Deep Trends and Data Insights



Questions to Answer:

- What **industry sectors** will shape our future?
- Who will live here in 20/30 years?
- How are the **schools** doing?
- What's the “playing field” for **development**?
- How can we accommodate **growth**?
- How do we leverage **innovation infrastructure**?
- What **neighborhoods** need help?
- **How equitable is our city's economy?**



Building Block 2: Economic Vision

Questions to Answer:


- How do we unite Civic **Leadership**?
- Can we **balance** existing assets with change?
- Can we **gracefully transition**?
- How do we grow our City's **prosperity** while ensuring that it is **more widely shared**?
- Do we need a **culture-shift** within the city gov?



Building Block 3: Projects and Priorities

Questions to Answer:

- What **5 to 10 initiatives** should be the focus?
- How do we **coordinate** and work with **partners**?
- Should Madison's ED Strategy be:
 - a) real estate driven (build what/where)?
 - b) sector driven (target industries)?
 - c) policy driven (change laws)?
 - d) entrepreneurship driven (start businesses)?
 - e) innovation driven (unleash ideas)?
 - f) *All of the above (how much of each)*



Building Block 4: Action Plan



Questions to Answer:

- How do we translate big vision into day-to-day tasks?
- What's the division of labor?
- What are the timelines and deadlines to?
- How do we measure success?
