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PEDESTRIAN-BICYCLE PROJECTS SOUGHT

The Madison Pedestrian-Bicycle-Motor Vehicle Commission will hold a public hearing to receive comments on potential pedestrian/bicycle projects the City should consider undertaking in the 2007-2009 Capital Budget to increase opportunities for walking and bicycling in Madison. Please note that concerns about routine maintenance and operational issues can be directed to the appropriate agency. **The intent of the public hearing is to hear suggestions for new capital (construction) projects.**

The hearing will be held at 6 p.m. on June 27, 2006, in Room 260 of the Madison Municipal Building, 215 Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard.
