I checked with staff members and did a little research on your question regarding deputy mayors. Although Washington DC, Detroit and other large cities have deputy mayors, it is not a position that is often used in Wisconsin municipalities. Curt Witynski, our Assistant Dir., indicated that the council president acts for the mayor in the mayor's absence but he is not aware of any personnel who currently have that title. The only city I could find who did have a deputy mayor is Oshkosh. Steve Cummings, current Mayor, served as Deputy Mayor in 2012. He might be a good person to talk to. 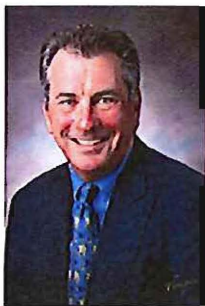
