





Petition for Walkway Lighting

We, the undersigned residents of the Barton Rd, Golden Oak Ln, and Redwood Ln area of Madison, hereby petition the City of Madison to install a light in the greenway located to the north of Barton Rd and Redwood Ln on the walkway at the location where the walks from Barton Rd, Prairie Rd, and Loreen Dr intersect. There is a utility pole at that location where the light could be installed. Currently, this is a very dark area at night where path users cannot see who or what is ahead of them on the walkway as they enter from Barton Rd, Prairie Rd, or Loreen Dr. The walkway is used by many area residents in the early evening for walking and biking, and a light would make the area safer for these uses. Further, the greenway late at night is frequently used for drinking alcohol, smoking marijuana, and sexual activity as evidenced by what neighbors whose back yards abut the walk hear and see, and by the beer cans, alcohol bottles, marijuana butts, and used condoms left by such activity. There are frequently groups of very noisy persons congregating late at night (11PM - 2 AM) at the walkway intersection. Neighbors in this area have also experienced many incidents of vandalism perpetrated at night by persons who escape detection by using the dark walkway to escape and avoid visual identification. It is very easy for the persons engaged in these activities to escape the police called to investigate because of the numerous exits/entrances to the greenway (on the walks as well as along the drainway to Hammersley Rd.)
