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<sup>i</sup> In 2008, an analysis was completed which calculated actual time spent by MPD officers in liquor licensed establishments. The total amounted to 14,770 hours, or the equivalent of seven full-time officers. Civilianized positions, including the proposed new Alcohol Compliance Officer, are not expected to replace the role of police with regard to policing of licensed establishments.
