SUMMARY:

Nardi explained that the mural is an initiative to pay homage to Otis Redding. It is a collaborative effort for two Brazilian artists and UW art students. The project received funding from the Art Department at UW, and they are ready to paint the mural with the City's approval.

Lee, representing the Marquette Neighborhood Association, registered in support of the mural as a positive impact for the neighborhood, especially considering recent violence in the area.

Levitan asked whether or not the mural has been designed yet. Levitan reiterated that the mural cannot appear commercial in nature and will need to be approved by zoning prior to painting.
