On November 23, 2004 the Common Council amended the ordinances to allow hiring authorities to allow an upward adjustment in leave entitlement for new appointments to non represented City positions. MGO 3.38 (7)(a) requires that "The Human Resources Director will report to the Board of Estimates on the use of this provision on an annual basis".
