

Hoffman Street Fiber Conduit Project

Wisconsin Independent Network will be extending fiber conduit in the City of Madison beginning February 7, 2013 and ending in March 2013. There will be a public hearing before the City of Madison Board of Public works on Wednesday February 6, 2013 at 5:30pm in Room 108 of the City County Building, 210 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Madison, WI. Contractors, hired by Wisconsin Independent Network, will bury the new conduit within the right of way, under the sidewalk and in the grass terrace, at the following locations:

- Conduit installation will begin at the intersection of Anderson Street and Hoffman Street. The conduit will be installed on the west side of Hoffman Street and continue north crossing Hoffman Street to the east into the median of Kinsman Blvd. The conduit will end at the intersection of Wright Street and Kinsman Blvd.

Restoration of any damage within the limits of the project, in the right of way, will be restored in accordance with the City of Madison standard specifications.
