Dear Transportation Commission,

I am a Lansing Street resident writing in support of the proposed two lanes of traffic with central turning lane option for Milwaukee Street (and thus opposed to the 4-lane option).

Our family lives very close to the Milwaukee-Lansing intersection and often witness the consistently high speeds of vehicles as described in the attached traffic data. We watch many pedestrians and bicyclists also using this road as key thoroughfare, especially lower income individuals who rely on the Woodman's grocery store near the Milwaukee-Hwy 51 intersection. In the winter, our neighbor whose home faces Milwaukee street routinely has vehicles run off the road onto the sidewalk and even their front yard.

If this committee wishes to honor the "high priority" designation given to pedestrian traffic as outlined in the attached presentation, then we must make decisions consistent with these values. For this reason, I urge the committee to enact the two lane option and reject the 4 lane plan.
