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**RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, the Community Development Authority of the City of Madison (CDA) owns and manages 904 units of subsidized housing throughout the City of Madison; and

WHEREAS, the Madison Gas and Electric Company (MGE) is the primary utility provider for housing owned by the CDA; and

WHEREAS, MGE is implementing a community solar program called Shared Solar, which offers MGE customers the opportunity to buy shares of the Shared Solar program to provide power from a community grid located in Middleton, Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the CDA has interest in providing renewable energy sources to residents in order to reduce our carbon footprint and provide clean energy to our residents; and

WHEREAS, participation in the Shared Solar program requires the CDA to agree to a Shared Solar Service Rider Pilot 1, known also as a Schedule Cs-1 agreement, which outlines the participation requirements and is found online at
