

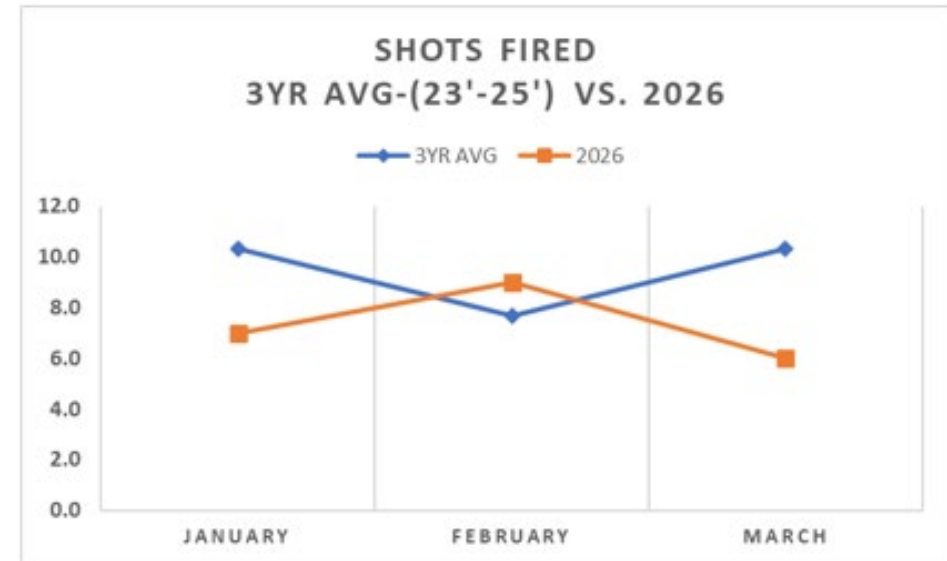

Shots Fired

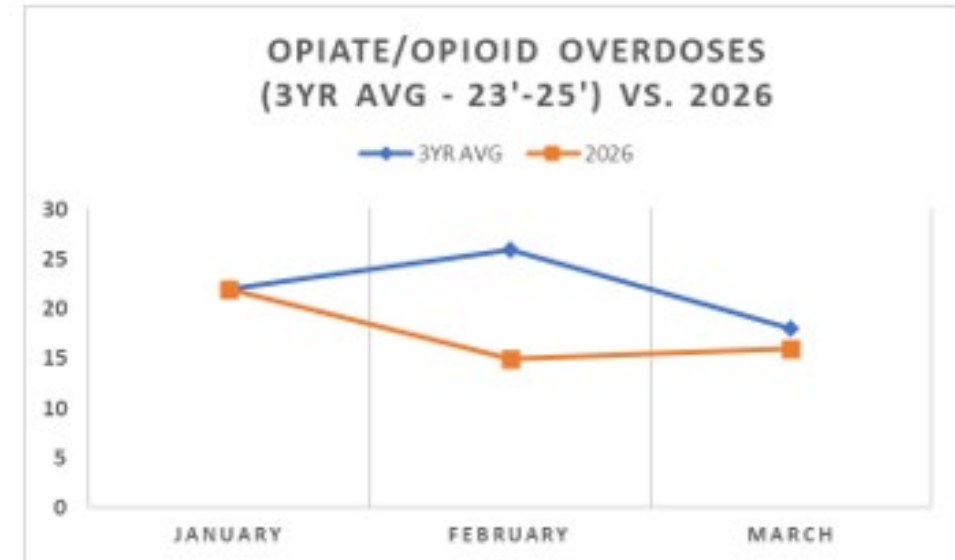
- There were 22 shots fired incidents in the City from January 1st through March 31st (2026).
- Through Q1 we saw a **26.7% decrease** in shots fired incidents compared to the 3-year average (30).





Opiate/Opioid Overdoses and Deaths

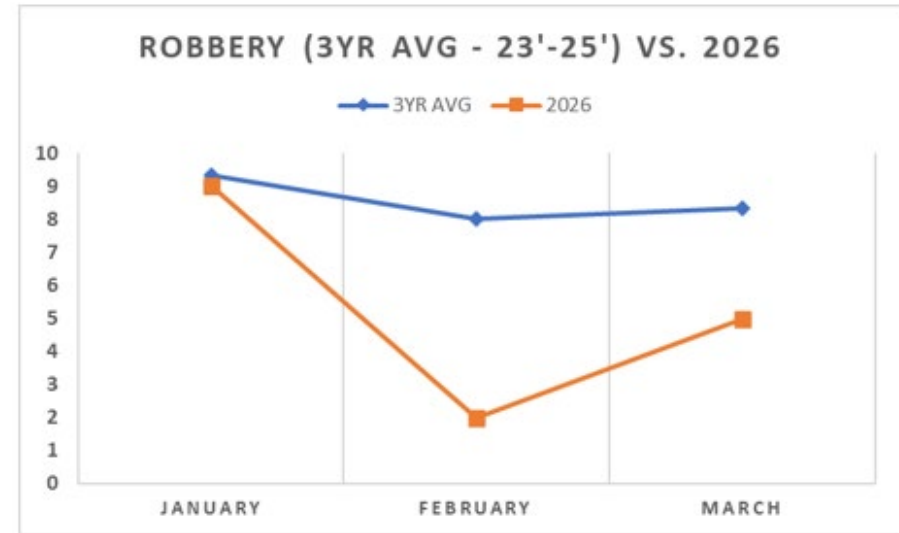
- Opiate/Opioid Overdoses – MPD responded to 53 known opiate/opioid overdoses during the 1st quarter of 2026. Through Q1 we saw a **20.9% decrease** in known opiate/opioid overdoses compared to the 3-year average (67).
- There were 5 suspected opiate/opioid overdose deaths during the 1st quarter of 2026.





Robberies

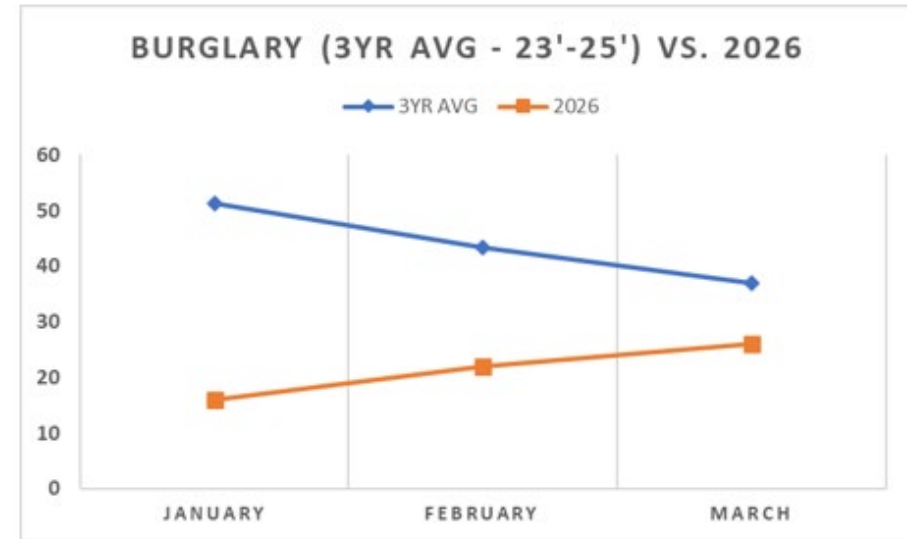
- There were 16 robberies reported in the 1st quarter of 2026.
- Through Q1 we saw a **38.5% decrease** of robberies reported compared to the 3-year average (26).





Burglaries

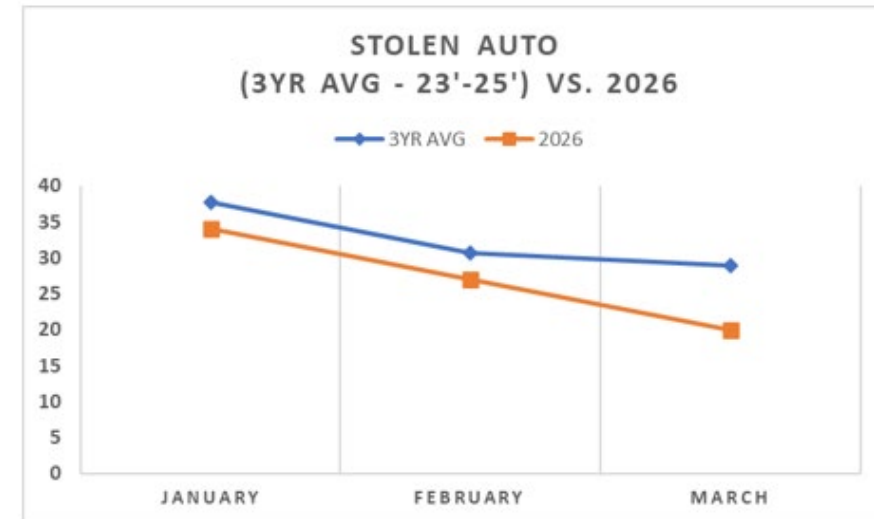
- MPD responded to 65 burglaries during the 1st quarter of 2026.
- Through Q1 we saw a **50.7% decrease** of burglaries reported compared to the 3-year average (132).





Stolen Autos

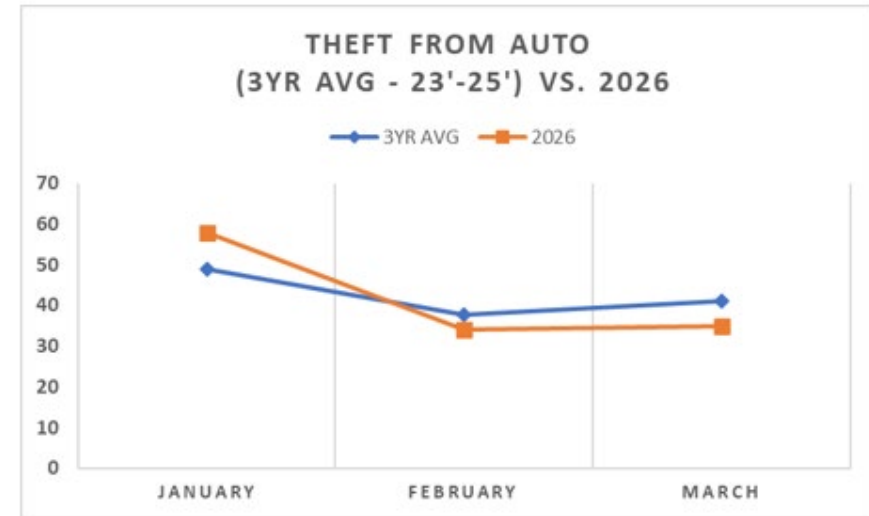
- MPD investigated 81 reports of stolen autos during the 1st quarter of 2026.
- Through Q1 we saw a **16.5% decrease** of stolen autos reported compared to the 3-year average (97).





Theft from Autos

- MPD investigated 128 thefts from vehicles during the 1st quarter of 2026.
- Through Q1 we saw no change regarding thefts from autos reported compared to the 3-year average (128).
