Staff recommendation: The Commission finds that the building has no known historic value. The Landmarks Commission recommends that the applicant secure and submit an approved Request to Disturb permit to the Preservation Planner and provide notification to the Ho-Chunk Nation Tribal Historic Preservation Office of the development plans as they relate to the burial site.

 - No City preservation file or WHS site file
 - Oregon Street Mounds site
