- Winnebago St – S Thornton Ave to S 2nd Street; Atwood Avenue – S 1st Street to S 2nd Street (Atwood Ave is a parallel route to Winnebago between S 1st and 2nd Streets, intersecting with Winnebago Street at S 2nd Street)

This set of studies and demonstration activities are Supplemental Planning and Demonstration Projects partially funded through the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Grant Program.
