The City of Madison is proposing to reconstruct the alley in Block 2 Wingra Park, bounded by the 1800 blocks of Monroe Street and Madison Street, in 2014. Enclosed with this letter is a fact sheet with some details on the proposed project along with a notification for the Public Hearing before the Board of Public Works. This project will involve special assessments to the owners of property adjacent to the project. The final assessment, which will be billed after the completion of the project, is payable in one lump sum or over a period of eight years, with 3.5% interest charged on the unpaid balance.

Storm Sewer: The existing storm sewer catchbasin, near Grant Street, will be retained.


Construction Schedule & Impacts
