DRAFTER'S ANALYSIS: This ordinance modifies the curfew hours for juveniles.			

The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:			
Subsection (1) entitled "Definitions" of Section 23.11 entitled "Minors Under Seventeen Not To Be Allowed On Streets After Certain Hours" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:			
"(1) Definitions. "Curfew Hours" means the following times: (a) From eleventen o'clock (41:0010:00) p.m. on any Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday until four o'clock (4:00) a.m. of the following day, and (b) From twelveeleven o'clock (12:0011:00) ap.m. until five o'clock (5:00) a.m. on any Friday or Saturday. "Custodian" means a person at least eighteen (18) years of age who has been authorized by a parent or guardian to have the care and custody of the juvenile. "Juvenile" means any person who is at least twelve (12) years of age but less than seventeen (17) years of age. "Organized Dance" means any school, church or non-profit sponsored dance, which has qualified for an exception under Madison General Ordinance Section 9.03(2)."
