
### **Committee Charge**

### **History**



- Company founded by German immigrant, Oscar F. Mayer (1859-1955)
- Acquired by General Foods in 1981
- Acquired by Kraft in 1989
- Located on Madison's north side for 97 years as a food production and headquarters facility
- Peak employment of 4,000 people in the 1970s




## **Land Use**
