ORDINANCE FILE #05511

The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:

Subdivision (f) entitled "Yard Requirements" of Subsection (2) entitled "Conservancy District" of Section 28.07 entitled "Special Districts" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

- "(f) Yard Requirements In the conservancy district, all buildings or structures, except for a civic auditorium complexes and elementary, middle and high schools, shall be provided with the following minimum front, side, and rear yards:
  - 1 Front yard--sixty (60) feet.
  - 2. Side yards--each side eighty (80) feet.
  - 3. Rear yard--one hundred (100) feet."
