5. Framework Plan Objective Most Directly Addressed by Proposed Activity:
Applicant has indicated that the proposal addresses the micro-enterprise objective. *✓*

6. Product/Service Description:
Applicant proposes to use CD funds to establish a vegan food distribution service for homeless persons. She would use church kitchens to prepare the food and use a van to distribute the food to the target population at various street corners and places throughout the Isthmus.

7. Anticipated Accomplishments (Numbers/Type/Outcome):
Proposal suggests that the 50 to 200 individuals would be served daily.

8. Staff Review:

Community need for vegan diet for homeless is not documented.
Proposed coordination with current programs to provide food and meals for this target population is not addressed.
Capacity of proposed organization is unclear, given lack of details, board formation, or set of operating procedures.
Cash flow for proposed service is entirely dependent on CD funds, with an initial gap of \$17,300/year to be raised from unidentified sources
Sustainability of this proposal as a micro-enterprise is not addressed. Product and service are unlikely to generate a revenue stream to make this organization a viable enterprise.
