- * An 18 month "rolling look-back" is undertaken every month. Volunteers who have not volunteered and staff do not know of their circumstance are contacted to determine their wishes to continue on as volunteers. Any volunteer who desires to continue being considered for volunteer opportunities at MSC are kept on the list. Any contact or change of service interest is updated at that time.

Also, there are some circumstances where volunteers who have disengaged from the Senior Center at a previous time are welcomed back (if their initial service was satisfactory) because their interest and circumstance has changed to allow re-engagement. These volunteers are reactivated.
